Summer is a time for sunshine, vacations, and fun adventures.

Whether you're heading to the beach, visiting family, or just relaxing at home, it's important to stay safe–not just in the sun, but online and on the phone, too! Keep reading to learn how to **protect yourself from tricky scammers** while you enjoy the season!

Don't Get Tricked by Scams

Scammers are getting sneakier, but they aren't using fancy technology. Most of the time, they use simple tricks that work when we're busy or not paying close attention. It's kind of like a sunburn–you don't notice it right away, but once it shows up, it already hurts.

At First Capital FCU, we've seen more fake emails and phone calls trying to trick people. Here's what you should know and how you can stay safe.

Phishing and Spoofing: Like a Sneaky Sunburn

Scammers send emails or texts that look real. They might pretend to be a streaming service, a delivery company, or even First Capital FCU. The message may say something like "Your payment didn't go through" or "Your account is locked." Then, they'll ask you to click a link or give your information. **One quick click, and they might steal**

Some scammers also make fake phone calls. The caller ID might say "First Capital FCU" or show our phone number. But the person on the phone may ask for your card number, passwords, or special codes.

Just like clouds don't stop a sunburn, a familiar name on your screen doesn't mean it's safe. **If something feels strange, stop.** Don't click the link. Hang up the phone.

How to Stay Safe

Don't trust links or caller ID right away. If something looks weird, call the company using a phone number from their real website.

Don't rush. Scammers want you to act fast so you don't think. Take your time and ask questions.

Keep your info private. First Capital FCU will never ask for your full card number, login details, or security codes by phone or email.

Call us if you're unsure. If you gave out your info or something just feels wrong, let us know. We're here to help.

We're Here to Keep You Safe

At First Capital FCU, your safety is very important to us. Anyone can be tricked by a scam—it doesn't mean you did something wrong. What matters is acting fast and getting help.

So stay alert. Listen to your gut. And remember:
